Appendix 1 – Club Practice/Recreation Guidelines

- Must hold either a One Event Recreation Licence or Annual Recreation Licence
- Correct sign on sheets must be used.
- Event Secretary **MUST** check all riders and ensure they have no suspensions and hold a current and correct licence for that event.
- All officials must hold a current Working With Children Certificate on their profile in Ridernet

Appendix 2 – Come & Try

- Participants do not need to hold a licence to participate (if they have never held a licence previously) and will be allocated a free 3-month Introductory Recreation Licence.
- All entries need to be taken on Ridernet where possible so that the 3-month Recreation Licence can be allocated prior to the event. *NOTE: if entries are taken on the day a profile should be created so that the licence can be linked by MV Staff)*
- Clubs' members are eligible to attend but **MUST** hold a current licence for the event. If you are allowing club members to attend, you **must** take out a practice permit in conjunction with the Come & Try Permit.
